- Two 30-bird Races on Saturday AM & PM, and one 30-bird Race on Sunday morning, AM only.
 - 08:00 AM 09:00 AM Practice, BREAKFAST available in clubhouse restaurant.
 - 09:00 AM 12:00 PM, 30-Bird Race
 - 12:00 PM 1:00 PM, LUNCH available in clubhouse restaurant.
 - 1:00 PM 4:00 PM, 30-Bird Race. Start time is dependent on the mornings' race finish time, and may have an earlier start.
- Cost is \$100.00 per 30-Bird Race (\$40.00 Entry fee & \$100.00 Club ZZ Bird card)
 - \$40.00 for the entry fee (cash only); \$30.00/per race is applied to the purse with 50/30/20 payout (all ties split), and \$10.00/per race is applied to the Pea-Draw. Only shooters who **did not** <u>place or tie</u> for 1st 2nd or 3rd are eligible for the Pea-Draw. The Pea-Draw will draw 2 names at the end of each race. The 2 Pea-Draw winners will split the Pea-Draw pot 50/50.
 - \$60.00 for the Club ZZ Bird Card. Shooters need to purchase their ZZ bird cards, min. of 30 birds, from the Tucson Trap and Skeet Clubs' office in order to enter the shoot. ZZ birds cost \$2.00 per bird, regardless of the number of birds purchased. Additional practice birds also need to be purchased, also \$2.00/per. The Club accepts credit cards or cash for the purchase of bird cards & ammo. The entry fee is \$40.00/per race, cash only, and paid at the ZZ bird ring during sign-up. Exact change is encouraged for sign-up.

General outline:

- > The shoot format will generally follow the USHA guidelines; 30 birds in 6 cranks/rounds with 5 birds each.
- The Tucson Trap and Skeet Club has (1) ZZ bird ring with (5) auto-loading machines.
 - The ring is generally setup according to USHA design requirements with a 2' high out-of-bounds fence, set ~21 meters away from the boxes. Any birds' white witness cap that does not separate completely and/or initially falls outside the out-of-bounds fence is considered a LOST bird.
 - The shooters' stand is at ~27 meters. No yardage increases or shoot-offs. All ties split.
- ➢ Prior to the Race, purchase your ZZ Bird cards at the Club house window for each 30-Bird Race you wish to enter. Specifically, if you want to shoot both days, all 3 Races, you will need to purchase (3) ZZ Bird cards. You may shoot any or all Races.
- > The shooter is allowed (2) shots per Bird. The maximum allowable gauge/ammo load is: 12 gauge, 1oz of lead shot with 7 1/2's or smaller shot, factory ammo.
- > All rulings/referee decisions (if needed) will have a shooter-friendly mind set.
- Separate shooter-administered purses/options will be available.
- > This is NOT a USHA team sponsored shoot, and scores will not count towards USHA team standings.

SAFETY in a priority!

- > There will be a safety briefing prior to each of the AM & PM shoots.
- > The Tucson Trap and Skeet Club requires EVERYONE to wear eye protection outside the Club house.

Ammo is available for purchase at the Club House. The restaurant will be open for breakfast and lunch.
